Objective of the Game

Disc Golf is played like traditional "ball" golf, but with flying discs instead of balls and clubs. One point (stroke) is counted each time the disc is thrown and when a penalty is incurred. The goal is to play each hole in the fewest strokes possible. The player with the lowest total strokes for the entire course wins.

SAFETY FIRST

Never throw when players or park users are within range. Always give park users the right of way. Be aware of your surroundings and environment.

• TEE THROWS

Each hole begins with a tee throw. Tee throws must be completed within or behind the designated tee area.

LIE

The lie is the spot where the player's previous throw has landed. Mark lie with a mini disc or turn over the thrown disc, directly towards the hole or designated fairway. The player's subsequent throw is made from directly behind the marked lie.

THROWING ORDER

The player with the least amount of strokes on the previous hole is the first to tee off on the next hole. After teeing off, the player whose disc is farthest from the hole always throws first.

• FAIRWAY THROWS

Fairway throws must be made from directly behind the lie. A run-up and normal follow-through, after release, is allowed, unless the lie is within 10 meters of the target. Any shot within 10 meters of the target requires that the player not move past the lie until the disc is at rest.

DOGLEG (or Mandatory)

A dogleg is one or more designated trees or poles in the fairway that must be passed as indicated by arrows. Until the dogleg is passed the closest foot to the dogleg must be on the lie when the disc is released.

COMPLETION of HOLE

A disc that comes to rest in the Disc basket or chains constitutes successful completion of that hole.

• UNPLAYABLE LIE

Any disc that comes to rest above the ground is considered an unplayable lie. The disc must be thrown from the lie on the ground, directly underneath the unplayable lie, relocated to avoid damage to the vegetation.

OUT of BOUNDS

If any area of O.B. is visible between the disc and O.B. line, then the disc is considered O.B. A throw that lands out of bounds, must be played from a point 3 feet in bounds from where the disc went out of bounds. Permanent water hazards and public roads are always out of bounds.

PENALTIES

Recreational players will not be penalized for rule infractions. Other players will keep you honest.

COURSE COURTESY

Adhere to the established Park rules

- No person or vehicle shall be allowed within the limits of any public park or playground area between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. during Eastern Standard Time and between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. during daylight saving time, except by special permission.
- No person shall possess, drink, sell or offer for sale any alcoholic beverages within the limits
 of a City recreational facility.
- Littering is strictly prohibited. Please utilize designated trash receptacles when available.
- The feeding of waterfowl is strictly prohibited as well as illegal in the State of Rhode Island.
 (RIDEM 2003)
- The use of cooking apparatus is permitted in restricted areas only. These areas are authorized by written permit issued by the City of Pawtucket and/or Parks & Recreation Division.
- The selling of goods and/or services are not allowed by any vendor within any City park, with the exception of a special event or the sponsorship of a recreational facility or Parks & Recreation program. Any exception requires written authorization from the Parks & Recreation Director.
- The alteration to any recreational facility and its grounds that have the potential to incur a negative impact to the environment or scheduled events are strictly prohibited without the written consent of the Department of Public Works Director as well as the Parks & Recreation Director.
- The use of inflatables, including bounce houses is not allowed without the expressed written consent of the Parks & Recreation Director
- Any pet should remain on a leash at all times
- Be aware of surroundings: including foot and/or bicycle traffic before throwing
- o Remain Quiet and avoid unnecessary movements while others are throwing
- Stand behind the player who is throwing until throw is complete
- o Remove disc from the basket after completing the hole
- Help new players learn the rules
- o Allow faster groups to play through when possible
- o Pick up trash whenever possible and dispose in proper receptacles throughout the Park.
- o Do not alter the course(trees, brush, etc) in any way
