


A QUICK TRIP TO THE CITY OF PAWTUCKET

It's easy to get here from anywhere...by air, bus, rail, water or highway



Easy Air Travel

T.F. Green Airport, the state's largest airport, underwent a \$200 million improvement project that was completed in the fall 1996. The state-of-the-art, 310,000 square foot, multi-level terminal offers the highest level of convenience, choice and service, and serves as the Gateway to New England. T.F. Green Airport is centrally located in Rhode Island with direct access from Interstate 95 making it less than 45 minutes from any part of the state and only about a 25 minute drive from downtown Pawtucket.

Easy Access by Bus

Extensive daily service is available to travelers arriving at T.F. Green or from any locality in Rhode Island who desire to travel to downtown Pawtucket via a Rhode Island Transit Authority (RIPTA) bus. In addition, out-of-state travelers who opt not to drive, can easily reach the City by traveling on buses operated by Peter Pan Lines and Greyhound.

Easy Train Travel

Easy access into the City of Pawtucket will be further enhanced by a planned high-speed AMTRAK rail service, resulting in a 30-minute train ride to Boston and a two-and-one-half hour ride to New York City. A commuter rail is located in South Attleboro, Massachusetts, just minutes away from the City's historic downtown.

Easy Automobile Travel

Interstates 95, 195, and 295 create easy access right into downtown Pawtucket from all points in the state. According to the City of Pawtucket Department of Planning and Redevelopment, about 150,000 travelers pass through the City of Pawtucket on Interstate 95 each day.

Just minutes off Interstate 95, the major north-south route on the East Coast, it is easy for travelers to reach the City of Pawtucket from major metropolitan areas, like Boston, New York, Philadelphia and Washington, DC. Here are the facts:
