## Medicare Part D Annual Open Enrollment

- \***October 15, 2016** Open Enrollment Begins
- \***December 7, 2016** Open Enrollment Ends

During Open Enrollment, Medicare beneficiaries have an opportunity to review their current health insurance and prescription drug coverage to make sure they are enrolled in the best plan that fits their needs. Open Enrollment is also a good time to see if you qualify for any additional assistance programs that can help you save money on your prescriptions. One-on-one counseling is available and **an appointment is required for all Open Enrollment counseling sessions.**

◆ Call the Center at 728-7582 to make an appointment. Thank you to the RI Division of Elderly Affairs, and our Senior Health Insurance Program partners for their assistance during open enrollment.

**Please Note: For anyone 65 and above you do not have to be concerned about the Health Insurance Market Place enrollment as part of the Affordable Care Act.**

### **Heating Assistance News**

A single person can earn up to \$2,378/month and a married couple can earn up to \$3,109/month to qualify for heating assistance (based on 2016 guidelines). If you are interested in applying for Heating Assistance you can make an appointment at the Senior Center's 2nd floor office or by calling 728-7582.




### WELLNESS SUPPORT
