I have read and understand Section 2704.1 of the Rhode Island State Building Code which states as follows: "It shall be unlawful to use or allow the use of, or to supply current for electrical systems in a building or structure unless the required certificate of inspection and permit have been issued by the code official."

If I violate the conditions of this affidavit and the service is altered without the proper permit, I fully understand that I will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.

In addition, after notification and a full and fair opportunity to be heard in the Pawtucket Municipal Housing Court, the power to the above referenced property may be shut off without further notice. I accept full responsibility and liability to any party or parties for this auction. Further, I full acknowledge that the City of Pawtucket and the Electrical Inspector shall not be held responsible for any liability to any party or parties for losses incurred by this action.
